AUTHORISATION TO ACT AS A COMPETENT AUTHORITY TO RECEIVE SHIP SECURITY ALERTS


Please be advised that the Department of Maritime Affairs, Ministry of Public Works, Utilities, Transport & Posts of the Government of Saint Christopher (Kitts) & Nevis recognises Morsviazputnik (SU04), Registered by the Federal Service of Telecommunication Inspection, Russian Federation, Licence No. 35298, as a designated Competent Authority according to the Merchant Shipping (Ship & Port Facility Security) Regulations, 2004, Section 11(2)(a) being authorised to receive and process as required, Ship Security Alerts from St. Kitts & Nevis ships in accordance with the provisions of SOLAS 74 (as amended) Chapter XI-2, Regulation 6.1.2.

Morsviazputnik are to promptly advise the office of the International Registrar of Shipping and Seamen, St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry of any St. Kitts & Nevis ships for which they are engaged by the Ship Owner or Manager (the Company) to receive Ship Security Alerts.

Morsviazputnik are to advise the Department of Maritime Affairs and St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry of any Ship Security Alerts in accordance with the instructions contained on the website of the St. Kitts & Nevis International Ship Registry, which is www.stkittsnevisregistry.net or which may be advised to Morsviazputnik in writing from time to time.

This Authorisation can be cancelled by giving 3 months notice to Morsviazputnik in writing to their Registered Office or by fax or email to their place of business.
